

MDSC Centennial Celebration Kickoff Conservation Projects

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Who: All Scouts, Scouters, Scouting Families, and friends of Scouting. Bring non-Scout friends to show them what Scouting is all about when conducting Community Service.

When: Two kickoff weekends, one on **September 12th** and one on **September 19th**.

What: For those units wanting to participate on September 12th, each unit can identify their own conservation service project to help in their community. Check with your Chartered Unit Organization, City, or County to find projects. For those units wanting to participate on the 19th, there are several already designated events that you can participate in.

It is also suggested that you use this as a recruitment event; inviting non-Scouts to join your group. Since this is a Council event, a tour permit is not required. Non-scouters are covered in terms of liability. Celebrate a hard day's work with a BBQ after the cleanup and encourage your non-Scout Guests to join Scouting. (Each Scouting unit to plan and sponsor their BBQ).
